General Functions: The Colorado Springs Promise Coordinator is responsible for working with the Executive Director of the Promise and collaborating with PPUW staff to accomplish the goals and actions expected of his or her work group—all in alignment with PPUW's vision: Through strengthened collaboration, PPUW achieves measurable improvements in education, income stability, and health for the residents of El Paso and Teller Counties.

This position is responsible for developing relationships to support increased high school graduation rates throughout the region, working with the Executive Director and Advisory Board on executing effective programing; work with school district personnel to identify students who would benefit from the program and help place the students in the proper program; and will access community assets on specific aspects of the program including: trauma, life design, career, life skills, and champions program.
